Day 1 : Gateway to Your Moroccan Adventure



Your 15-day Morocco tour from Casablanca begins in this dynamic coastal city where modern energy meets ancient tradition. After a warm airport welcome, your journey starts with a visit to the iconic Hassan II Mosque, its 210-meter minaret rising dramatically above the Atlantic Ocean. During your guided tour, admire the masterful zellij mosaics, carved cedarwood, and the impressive retractable roof that showcases the brilliance of Moroccan craftsmanship.

Begin your Moroccan journey in the vibrant coastal metropolis of **Casablanca**. After airport pickup, explore the awe-inspiring **Hassan II Mosque**, whose 210-meter minaret towers over the Atlantic. Admire the intricate zellij tilework and retractable roof during your guided visit. Stroll along the Corniche, where locals gather at sunset for fresh orange juice and ma'amoul pastries. As dusk falls, check into your hotel near the medina, where the call to prayer mingles with the city's hum — a perfect introduction to Morocco's sensory tapestry. **Tip:** Sip your first Moroccan mint tea at **Café Maure**, overlooking the mosque's illuminated facade.

Day 2 : Imperial Cities & Coastal Charms



Today reveals Morocco's contrasting capitals. In **Rabat**, walk through the ochre walls of the **Royal Palace (Mechouar)**, then stand beneath the unfinished **Hassan Tower**, a 12th-century minaret framed by 200 elegant columns. Continue north to **Tangier**, where Africa meets Europe. Wander through the **Petit Socco**, once frequented by Beat Generation writers, and visit the **American Legation Museum**, the only U.S. National Historic Landmark abroad. Your riad in the kasbah

offers panoramic views of the **Strait of Gibraltar**, perfect for reflecting on your first full day of this immersive tour.

Day 3 : Into the Blue Pearl



Depart early for the **Rif Mountains** and arrive in **Chefchaouen**, Morocco's enchanting blue city. Founded in 1471 as a Moorish fortress, its blue-washed walls were originally painted by Jewish refugees to mimic the divine. Climb the cobbled alleys to **Plaza Uta el-Hammam**, sipping almond milk at Café Clock. Hike to the **Spanish Mosque** for a sunset view that transforms the blue medina into a living watercolor painting.

Step back in time as you explore **Meknes**, the "Versailles of Morocco," where Sultan Moulay Ismail's 25-km walls enclose the monumental **Bab Mansour gate**, adorned with intricate calligraphy. Nearby, the ancient Roman city of **Volubilis** reveals mosaics, including the famed **Bacchus House**, set among olive groves. Arrive in **Fes** by evening and settle into your riad near the **Bou Inania Medersa**, immersing yourself in the city's scholarly and spiritual legacy, filled with the scent of

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cedar and distant echoes of Quranic recitation.

Day 5 : Into the Labyrinth



Discover **Fes**, a living medieval city. Begin at the **Al Quaraouiyyin University** (founded 859 AD), then navigate the **Chouara Tannery**, where leather is dyed in stone vats using methods unchanged for centuries. Explore the Jewish Quarter's 17th-century synagogues, and as evening falls, wander the lantern-lit alleys of the **Kissaria**, perfect for finding hand-embroidered kaftans and traditional crafts.

Day 6 : From Alps to Dunes

Cross four ecological zones today. Stop in **Ifrane**, a Swiss-style town with art deco buildings, then wander through the **Cedar Forest**, where Barbary macaques play among the trees. Descend the lush **Ziz Valley**, lined with over 200,000 rustling palm trees. Arrive in **Merzouga** at sunset and mount your camel to trek across the apricot-lit **Erg Chebbi dunes**. Your luxury desert camp offers private tents with ensuite bathrooms while Berber staff prepare **medfouna** (stuffed, sand-baked

Day 7 : Sands of Time



End the day with a tagine dinner of lamb with dates and almonds, followed by drumming around the fire — the perfect culmination of your Sahara experience.

Wake to a **Sahara sunrise**, painting the dunes in molten gold. Venture by 4x4 to **Khamlia village**, home of the Gnawa people, whose trance-inducing music on handmade guembri lutes echoes across the sands. Visit a nomadic Berber family to prepare mint tea in their goat-hair tent and hear stories of desert life. At twilight, climb the highest dune for **360° views** of Algeria's mountains shimmering in the heat haze.

Day 8 : Canyon Lands



Journey west to the **Todgha Gorges**, where limestone walls soar 300 meters above the narrow canyon floor. Stop at Café Imlil for almond-stuffed dates, then hike along the turquoise river, passing Berber children tending goats. Continue through the **Dades Valley**, with surreal “monkey finger” rock formations glowing amber at sunset. Your cliffside hotel offers panoramic views, rooftop stargazing with a local astronomer, and a **hammam with rose-oil treatments** to soothe desert-weary muscles.

Day 9 : Roses & Kasbahs



Spend a slower day exploring **rural life in the High Atlas foothills**. Hike through the **Dades Valley**, visiting Berber villages and marveling at the striking **Monkey Fingers** rock formations. This peaceful day offers a contrast to the previous adventure-filled days, providing insight into local traditions and landscapes.

Day 10 : Hollywood’s Kasbah



Travel the legendary **Road of 1000 Kasbahs** to **Ait Ben Haddou**, a UNESCO clay fortress famed for **Gladiator** and **Game of Thrones**. Cross the Ounila River to explore the kasbah, then climb to the **agadir granary** for panoramic Atlas views. Stay at a boutique hotel in a restored pasha’s residence, enjoying an exclusive rooftop dinner under the illuminated kasbah. Don’t miss the saffron-infused **harira soup**, crafted using techniques unchanged since caravan days.

Day 11 : High Atlas Crossing



Cross the dramatic **Tizi n’Tichka Pass** (2,260m), witnessing Berber shepherds guiding flocks along hairpin turns. Pause at **Taddart Viewpoint** for mint tea with sweeping desert vistas. Descend into Marrakech, where the landscape transforms from snow-capped peaks to lush palm groves. Arrive at your riad in the **Mouassine quarter**, scented with orange blossoms. In the evening, experience the vibrant **Jemaa el-Fnaa square**, alive with snake charmers, storytellers, and

Gnawa musicians.

Day 12 : Red City Secrets



Explore Marrakech’s rich history, starting at **Ben Youssef Madrasa**, with cedar screens carved to mathematical precision. Visit the **Bahia Palace**, noting intricate zellij tilework and cooling floor designs. After lunch at **Nomad**, discover vintage Morocco at the **Maison de la Photographie**. End the day at **Le Jardin Majorelle**, where Jacques Majorelle’s cobalt-blue studio is hidden among hundreds of cacti, offering a serene retreat from the bustling city.

Day 13 : Atlantic Interlude



Head to the coast, stopping at an **argan forest** to see goats climbing trees. In **Essaouira**, stroll along the **Skala de la Ville ramparts**, visit the fish market, and enjoy freshly grilled seafood. If visiting in June, experience the **Gnaoua Music Festival**, or enjoy impromptu street performances year-round. Your beachfront hotel serves **thyme honey pancakes** at breakfast — ideal for windsurfing or exploring the thuya wood souks.

Day 14 : Return Journey



Trace the Atlantic coast back to Casablanca, stopping in **Oualidia** for a lobster tajine lunch overlooking flamingo-studded lagoons. Back in Casablanca, visit the **Habous Quarter** and the Royal Palace gardens (open Fridays). Conclude with a farewell dinner at **Rick’s Café**, featuring pigeon b’sstilla — a crisp, savory pastry capturing your journey’s flavors.

Day 15 : Morocco Journey’s End



Your 15-day adventure concludes with one last **Moroccan mint tea at the airport**, a final taste of the country’s famed hospitality.
